Safety Excellence Award

The Mississippi Agricultural and Forestry Experiment Station (MAFES) will recognize staff, faculty, or team who have made demonstrated efforts toward safety. The winner(s) will receive a plaque and a \$1,000 check.

Eligibility

- 1. All MAFES staff, faculty, and/or teams thereof (excluding administrators at the Department Head level or higher) are eligible for nomination.
- 2. All MAFES staff and faculty are eligible.
- 3. No recipient of the award will be eligible for renomination for 3 years.

Nomination Process

- Nominator must complete the Nominee Information Form and the required supporting material.
- 2. Nominations must include at least two letters of support, one of which must be from the nominee's supervisor and one can be from the nominator.
- 3. Other supporting materials, including examples of safety programs led/attended at Mississippi State University, recognized safety training programs attended (i.e. OSHA, American Farm Bureau Federation, etc.), impact of safety programs on MAFES personnel, etc. may be included in the nomination packet.
- 4. The nomination packet, including all supporting documentation, shall not exceed 5 pages in total length.
- 5. All documentation must be submitted as a **single** pdf document to nominations@cals.msstate.edu.

Selection Process

A committee will be appointed by the MAFES Director to select a winner each year. Previous award winners may be considered for committee service.
